

# Solution to Making a Liszt

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- Each music stanza corresponds to a word.
- Each word is found by reading off the note names of each of the notes present. And has one missing letter corresponding to the rest in the measure.
- This missing letter can be determined through a combination of possible words based on the existing letters and the hint from the music title given for each stanza.
- By combining all of these missing letters, you get **SCHUBERT**.
