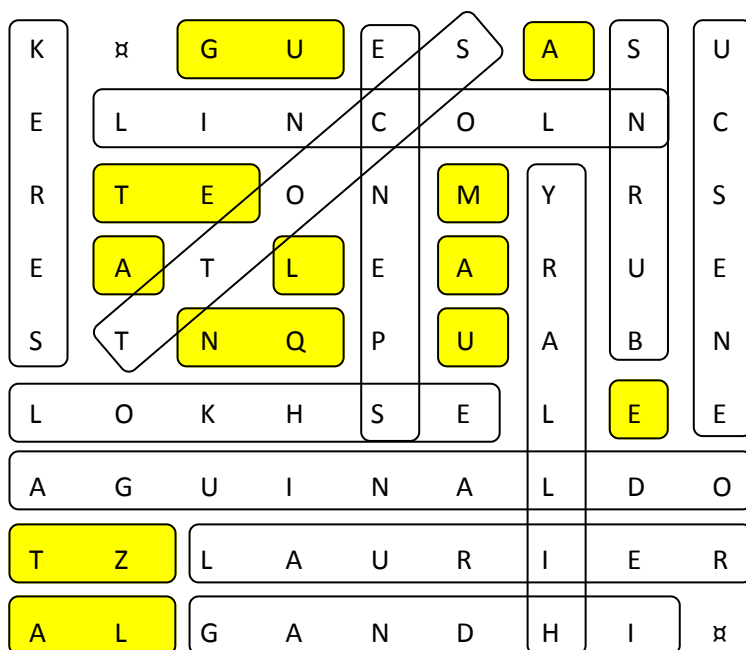


Solution to Who The \$€£¥¤!

This was a basic word find, where the word list is comprised of the last names of people who appear or who have appeared on the 5-unit currency notes of assorted countries. This is clued by the title (“Who”, 5 currency symbols, “5th”) and the flavortext (Jefferson appears on the nickel, the coin equivalent; the reference to wallet = money). There are 11 words total (also clued by the flavortext), all at least 5 characters long (doubly clued by the 5 references).

The remaining letters spell out “GUATEMALAN QUETZAL” (surrounded by the generic currency symbol), the national currency of Guatemala; repeating the theme of the puzzle, the answer is the last name of the person on the 5-Quetzal note, or **BARRIOS**.
