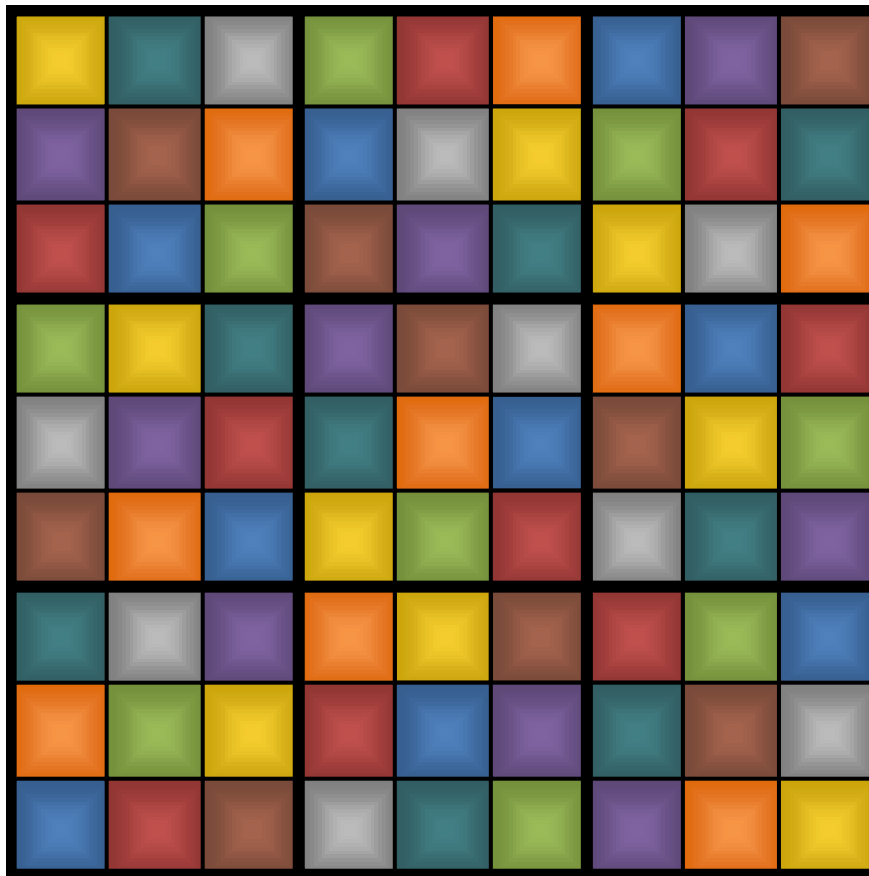


Solution to Bank Account

This is the meta-puzzle. First, notice the grid is a Sudoku using colors instead of numbers. Solve it.



The tiles scattered through all the books match the squares in the Sudoku. The completed Sudoku grid helps guide where certain colors will go, but you still need more information. The solutions to all the other puzzles are needed to connect the tiles.

The rules for finding the words are:

- The letters to a word go along a single path, and path includes letters only when it enters or exits a tile.
- Letters are only used once.
- Letters from a word are always sequential—next to each other. Because loops can exist, the letters from a word might be scrambled, but it’s generally easy to figure this out.
- Any path with more than one letter has a puzzle solution on it, and easy path has only one.

The easiest way to go about finding words is to use letter frequency. Q and Z only appear once. The letter counts from all the tiles are:

Once you find the tiles that create the path with the answer, use the Sudoku to position the tiles. Continue until you’ve built the entire board.
