Beat the House

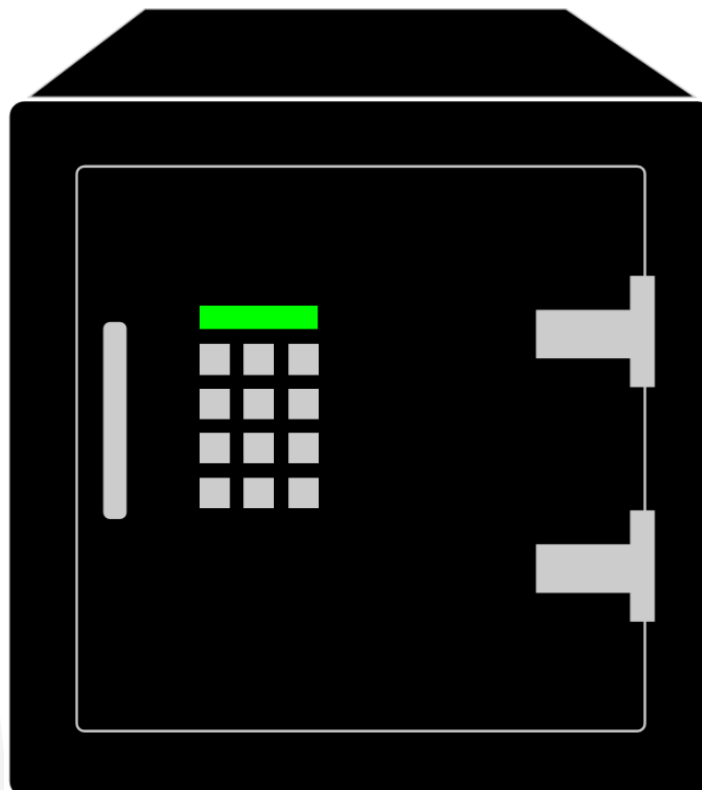
