

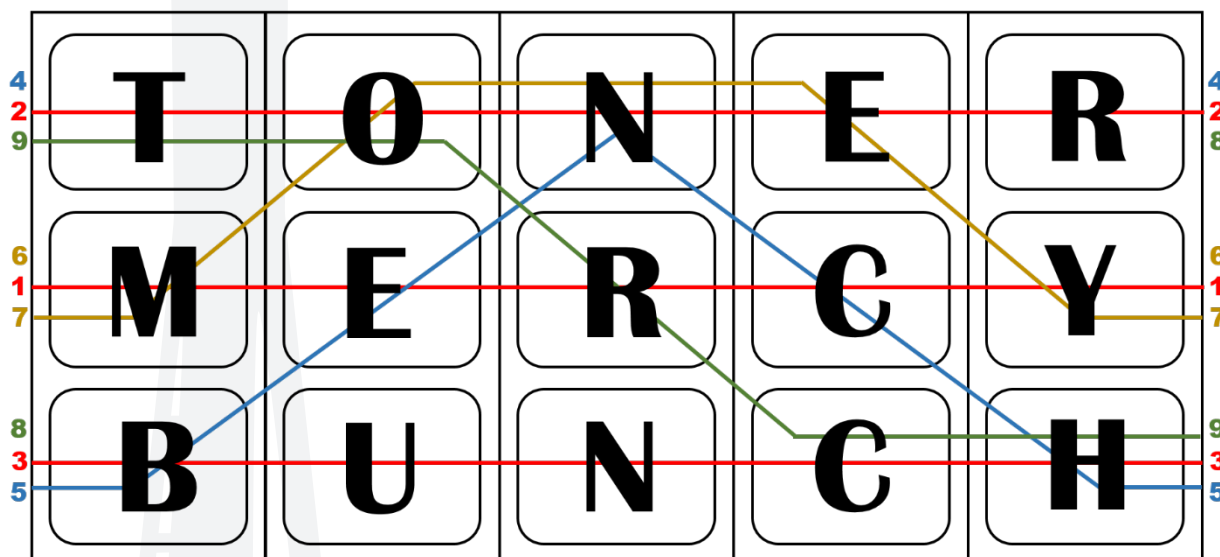
Keepin' It Reel

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The words along the paylines are:

- A group of things, usually held together; a considerable amount: **BUNCH**
- Flashlight? Never heard of that before in Australia: **TORCH**
- Used in laser printers: **TONER**
- People usually leave Vegas with less of this: **MONEY**
- The rule that is invoked when the local Little League team scores too many runs: **MERCY**
- Wide piece of furniture that can offer relative comfort to many people at a time, both indoors and outdoors: **BENCH**

To get all the words onto a payline, the letters should be arranged in the following manner:



The coordinates at the bottom of the puzzle are used to extract the puzzle solution. The first dimension represents a payline number and the second dimension represents the column number. For example, (9, 4) represents column 4 in payline 9, which is the letter **C**. The solution from extracting all the letters is **CONMEN**.
