In roulette, a six line bet is a bet on two consecutive rows of numbers. That's a 3x2 grid, which when combined with the flavor text ("don't see") should guide towards the use of braille in this puzzle. The chips don't form letters on their own, but if you mark all the squares that the chips are betting on, then read it in braille from top down, you get **SYSTEM**.
