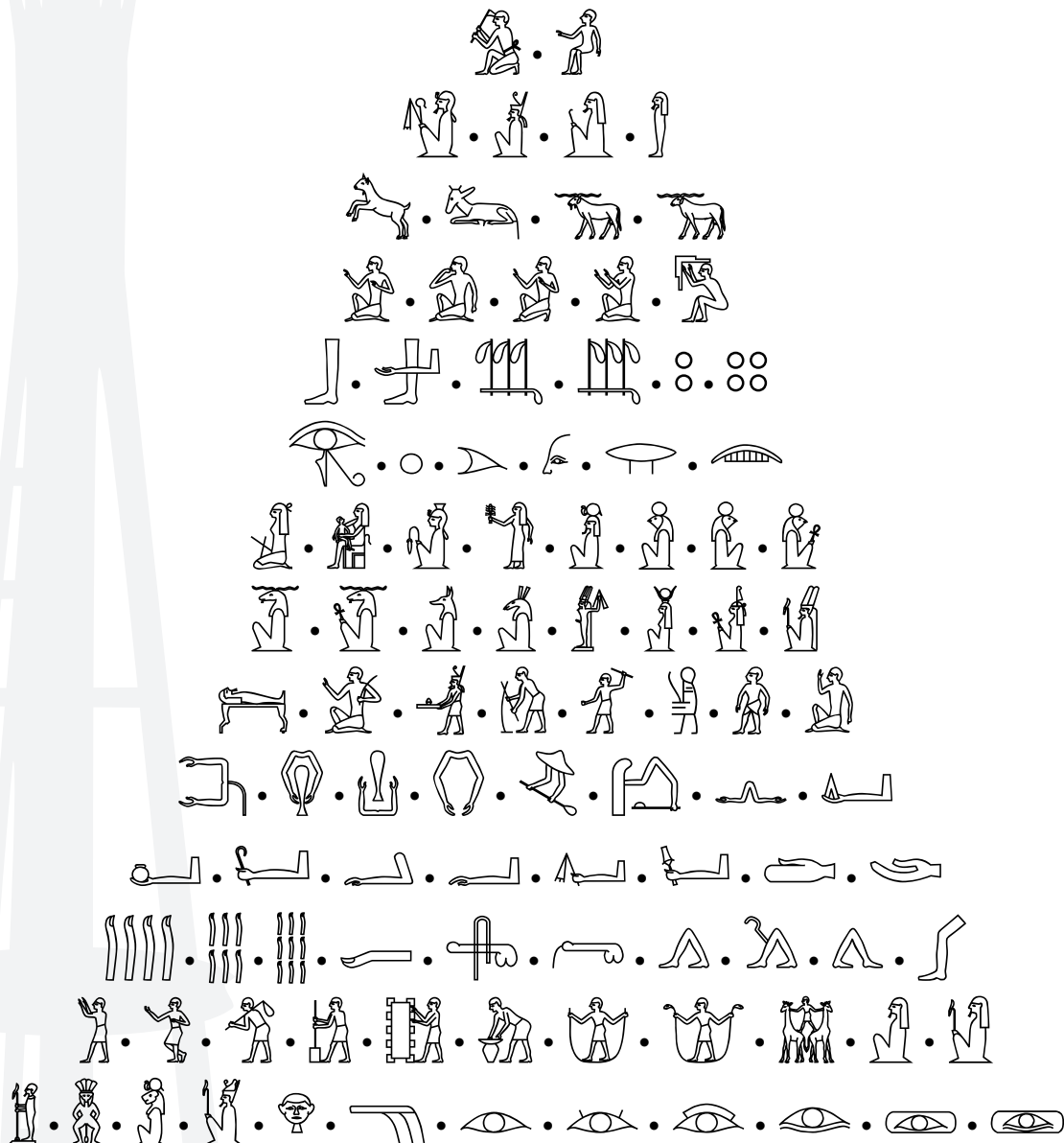


To Egypt From Luxor
