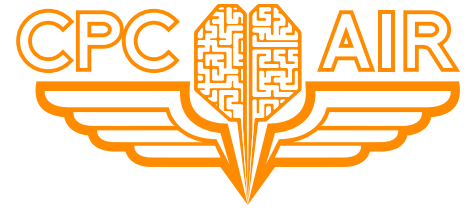


TERMINAL CROSSINGS ^{1/3}

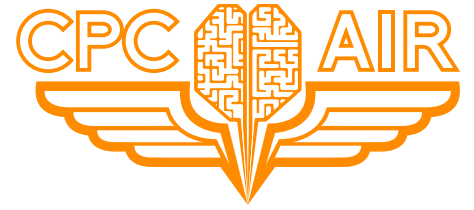
