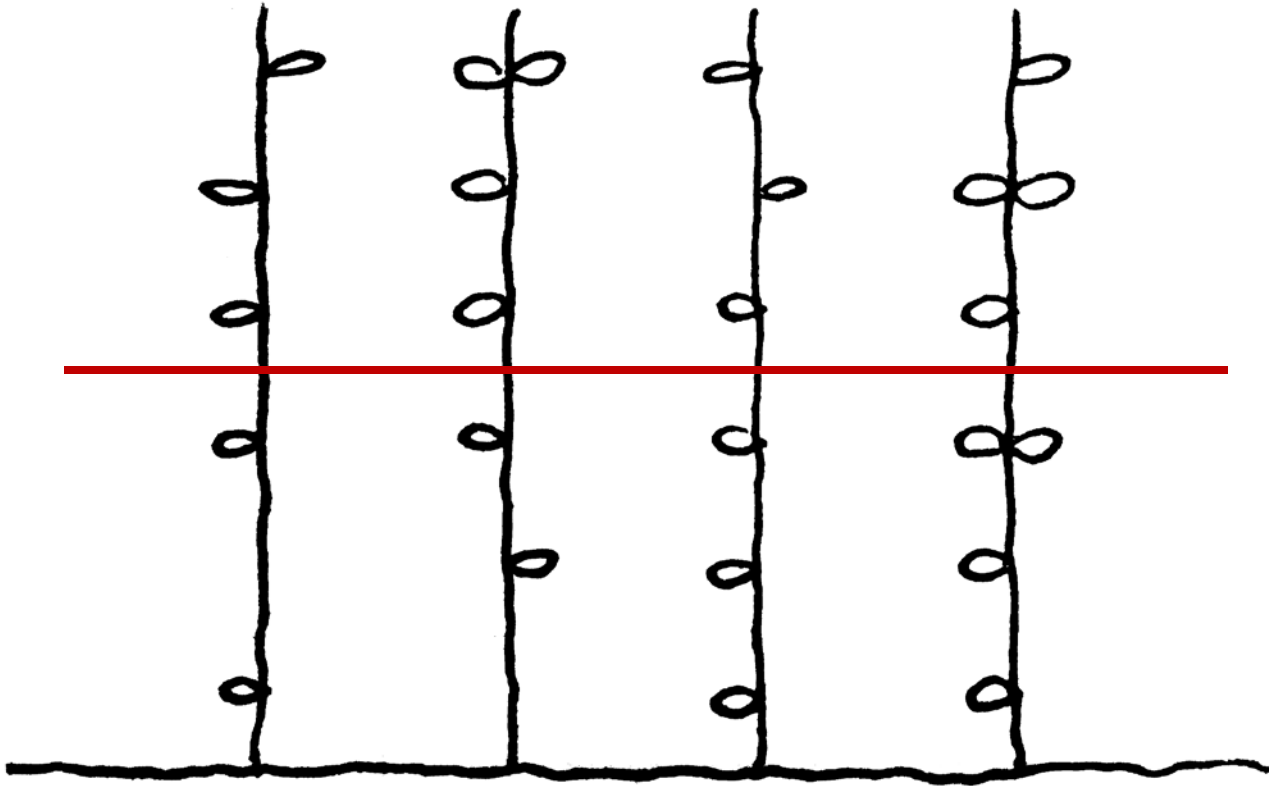


SOLUTION: See Weed

Each seaweed stalk can be split into two Braille patterns. Reading left to right, top to bottom provides the answer.



New to Puzzles? Editor Notes:

Often, the title of a puzzle will contain an important clue. In this puzzle, the common noun "seaweed" has been rewritten into "See Weed". In terms of visual clues, the fish swimming at the top of the page are also missing their eyes—they're blind. That suggests that the [Braille alphabet](#) is important in this puzzle. Braille is a common encoding type used in puzzles, and solvers should familiarize themselves with [many others](#) that often appear in puzzles.

You may have realized by now that there is rarely an explicit "question" being asked in a puzzle. When solving puzzles, you're supposed to "figure it out"—and that also means figuring out *what* the puzzle is. 🤔
