



Curses!

First, cut out the triangles. Half of them have words on them, and these words can be paired together to form names of web colors. Once that's done, you'll have a strip of 10 triangles. The other 10 don't have words, but they each share a color with one of the other 10. You can pair these triangles together by gluing or taping them together.

The next step is to realize that these triangles need to be formed into a trihexaflexagon. Joining the pieces together and folding it correctly will result in the word SUBMIT appearing around the first face of the trihexaflegaxon, indicating this is the right path. Folding to the other faces will reveal TRIHEX and COLORS respectively, indicating you should submit TRIHEX COLORS.
