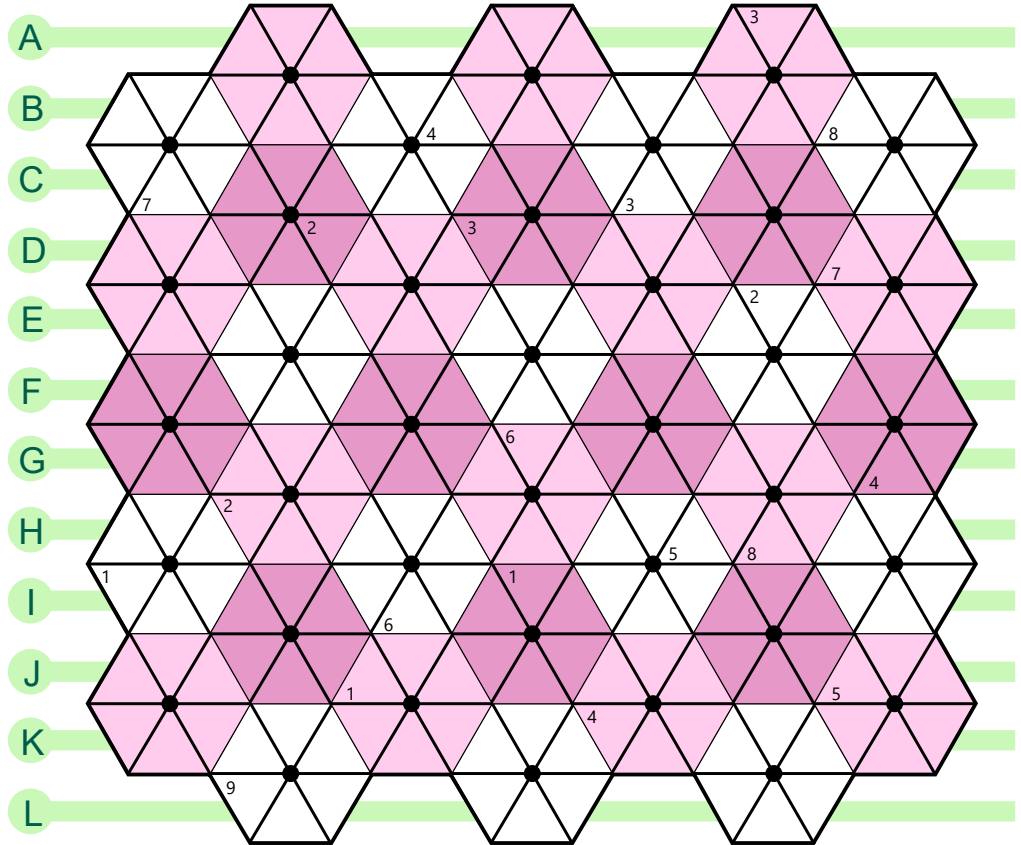


Flower Bouquet

Answers fit into this trick flower bouquet in two ways. Row answers read horizontally from the lettered line markers; each row contains multiple consecutive answers reading from left to right (except rows A and L, which contain one answer each). Blooms are six letter answers that fill the white, light pink, and dark pink hexagons. They can read either clockwise or counterclockwise and start from any petal in the bloom. All three bloom lists are in alphabetical order; use the row answers to place blooms in the correct spots.
