



Magica Squares

A Magica Square is an arcane magical square where:

- Only numbers 1 through 9 appear, and always once in every row, every column, and the two main diagonals.
- Subsquares, if any, also contain numbers 1 through 9 once.

An Example Magica Square with 0 subsquares:
