



Forest Flora

Welcome to the magical forest! This forest is filled with enchanted greenery but today, we are looking for the most non-magical of plants. We haven't identified what it is yet, but we do know a bit about its behavior. This plant requires a tree for sustenance and always grows in a space horizontally or vertically adjacent to its tree. Trees can only support one plant each, so there are as many plants as there are trees. Despite their symbiotic relationship with trees, these plants do not get along with one another. Plants cannot be in adjacent spaces, including diagonally. From previous explorations, we've marked how many plants will be found in each row and column on the forest map below. One of the plants in each row will also help identify what species this is.
