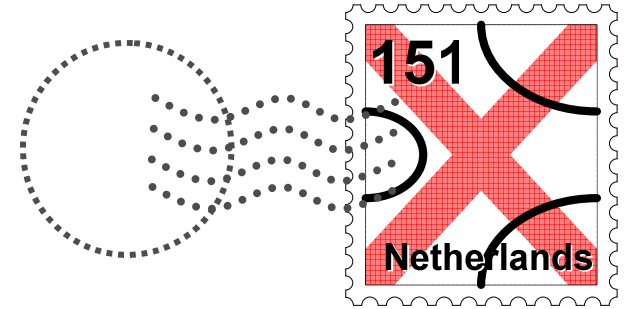
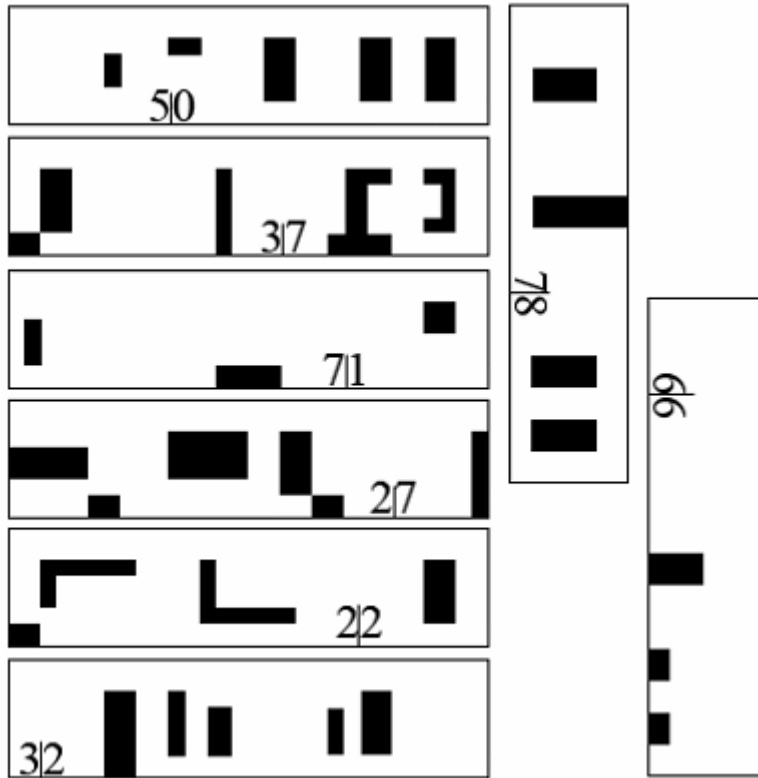


CN Tower

After the pouring over 40,000 cubic metres of concrete, and 40 months of construction, the CN tower opened June 26, 1976. The tower was originally designed as a communications tower to alleviate poor television signals caused by Toronto's 1960s skyscraper construction boom. Since construction, the 553.3 m tall world's tallest freestanding structure, has seen a steady move away from its original purpose to its current focus as a tourist attraction and symbol of the city.
