

Solution to Travelling From St. to St.

Some clues may be ambiguous, but after solving a few the pattern should emerge that the two clues differ by only two letters. In addition, the two letters that differ in the before and after are always state abbreviations, which is hinted at by using "St." in the title.

The words corresponding to the clues are:

BACKBOARD	BACKBONED
ORION	SCION
UTLEY	WILEY
NIN	NWA
GANDER	HINDER
SAKS	SAND
LOCO	LOIN
TRIO	TARO

TGAORRI INSCOBOKSTUTAR
TGAORRI INSCOBOKSTUT**NE**
TGAS**CR**I INSCOBOKSTUTNE
TGASCR**I** INSCOBOKST**WI**NE
TGASCR**WA**SCOBOKSTWINE
THISCR**I**WASCOBOKSTWINE
THISCR**I**WASCOB**ON**DTWINE
THISCR**I**WAS**IN**BONDTWINE
THIS**CA**RWASINBONDTWINE

This gives the phrase, "This car was in Bond TWINE" referring to the James Bond movie "The World is Not Enough."
This abbreviation can be easily found with a Bing search for "bond twine" or even "bondtwine."
Thanks to brilliant product placement, the car featured in that movie was the **BMW Z8**.
