- Inherit the **R**ind/**R**ind/**W**ind
- A Christmas **C**aramel/**C**arol
- Of Mice and **M**eat**b**alls/**M**en
- A Midsummer Night's **C**ream/**D**ream
- War and **P**each/**P**eace
- The Lord of the **W**ings/**R**ings
- The Horse and His **S**oy/**B**oy
- Mostly Hamless/**H**armless
- The Da Vinci Cod/**C**ode
- The Old Man and the **S**eltzer/**S**ea
- Speaker for the **B**read/**D**ead

If you take the replaced letters, it gives you the answer, which is a similar title (though with 2 replacements):
