

Solution to Can't We All Just Get Along

The logic puzzle solves as follows:

- Muslim - Seattle - Corey
- Wiccan - Orlando - Ethan
- Atheist - Xenia - Oliver
- Jewish - Indianapolis - Ian
- Buddhist - Chicago - Tom
- Taoist - Tampa - Xavier
- Christian - El Paso - Scott
- If the people are listed out in the order given in the puzzle, the first letter of their first names spells out COEXIST. Similarly for the cities if listed out in the order given in the puzzle, their first letter also spells COEXIST.
- The word COEXIST is on a famous bumper sticker (bumper sticker is hinted in the flavor text), seen below.



- Each of the letters in the bumper sticker corresponds to a symbol that represents one of the “religions” in this puzzle as follows (information found at <http://www.stampandshout.com/shop/bumper-stickers/coexist.php>)
 - C - Islam
 - O - Wicca
 - E - Atheism
 - X - Judaism
 - I - Buddhism
 - S - Taoism
 - T - Christianity
- With this mapping, we can look through the puzzle itself for each appearance of the religion, we notice that each numbered clue has either one or none of these concepts.
- Thus we can convert each clue to a letter (or a space), if we do this we spell out:
TOSS SIX CITIES SCOTTS IS IT
- As there are seven cities, we can eliminate six of them to only leave the city Scott is from: **EL PASO**
